PHI DELTA THETA HOSTS ALCOHOL EDUCATION

For more than 50 years, there has been a Greek Community presence at Minnesota State University, Mankato. Throughout the years, each of the fraternities and sororities has lived up to the Greek Community core values through providing examples of service, leadership, scholarship and friendship. One Greek fraternity, Phi Delta Theta, is celebrating 50 years of commitment and legacy.

Over the years, Phi Delta Theta has dedicated some of their outreach incentives to providing alcohol education for the greater Minnesota State Mankato student population. This year, during the week of October 20th – 24th, Phi Delta Theta participated in Collegiate Alcohol Awareness Week. Throughout the week, the fraternity will be serving "mocktails" from a root beer keg in the Centennial Student Union to encourage conversation about the dangers of consuming alcohol.

In order to kick off the Collegiate Alcohol Awareness Week, Phi Delta Theta hosted House Party on October 16th. Over the last 12 years, Phi Delta Theta has been hosting House Party at their off-campus fraternity house. They have also partnered with Student Health Services, numerous Minnesota State Mankato departments and community organizations to provide an alcohol education event for the larger campus community. During this event, students tour a mock house party to witness various scenes from a sober perspective. Throughout the tour, students witness various scenarios they may encounter at such parties.

During the event, more than 300 Minnesota State Mankato students toured the home during the two hour event. Following the tour, students engaged with various staff members from the University in conversation about their experience.

Phi Delta Theta hopes that through both of these events, information will be more available for students regarding how to make smart choices and how to ask for help. Hopefully, each of the events will spark continuing conversations about the overuse and abuse of alcohol that is becoming more common.
