

# International Transfer Student Credit Evaluation

Transferring to a program abroad can be stressful, but it doesn't have to be. Follow these steps for an easier transition with less stress and more academic credit!

## Apply to Minnesota State University, Mankato

- You need to include English-language university and college transcripts in your application packet. Copies of official transcripts are acceptable.



## Attend Virtual 1-on-1 Transfer Advising

- Meet with a trained peer advisor to review important next steps for the transfer process.
- Learn about the benefits of credit evaluation & how it will help you complete your degree.

## Request & Pay for ECE Credential Evaluation

- To transfer credits, you must provide a credit evaluation after admission.
- Request a "Course-by-Course" report through the [online portal](#) and pay the ECE fee.

## Gather All Course Documents & Bring them to International Orientation

- To maximize your transferred credits, bring copies of course transcripts, book lists, syllabi, or any other document that will indicate material covered in each course. **This is especially important for major-related courses.**

## Attend Group Advising & Registration during Orientation Week

- Receive the latest information on program and course requirements, help with understanding your DARS, and map out the remainder of your coursework.

## Follow Up with SRC after Orientation to Complete Major Evaluations

- Major evaluations may take up to 4 weeks.
- Faculty members and departments make the final decision about whether transfer courses will fulfill major requirements.
