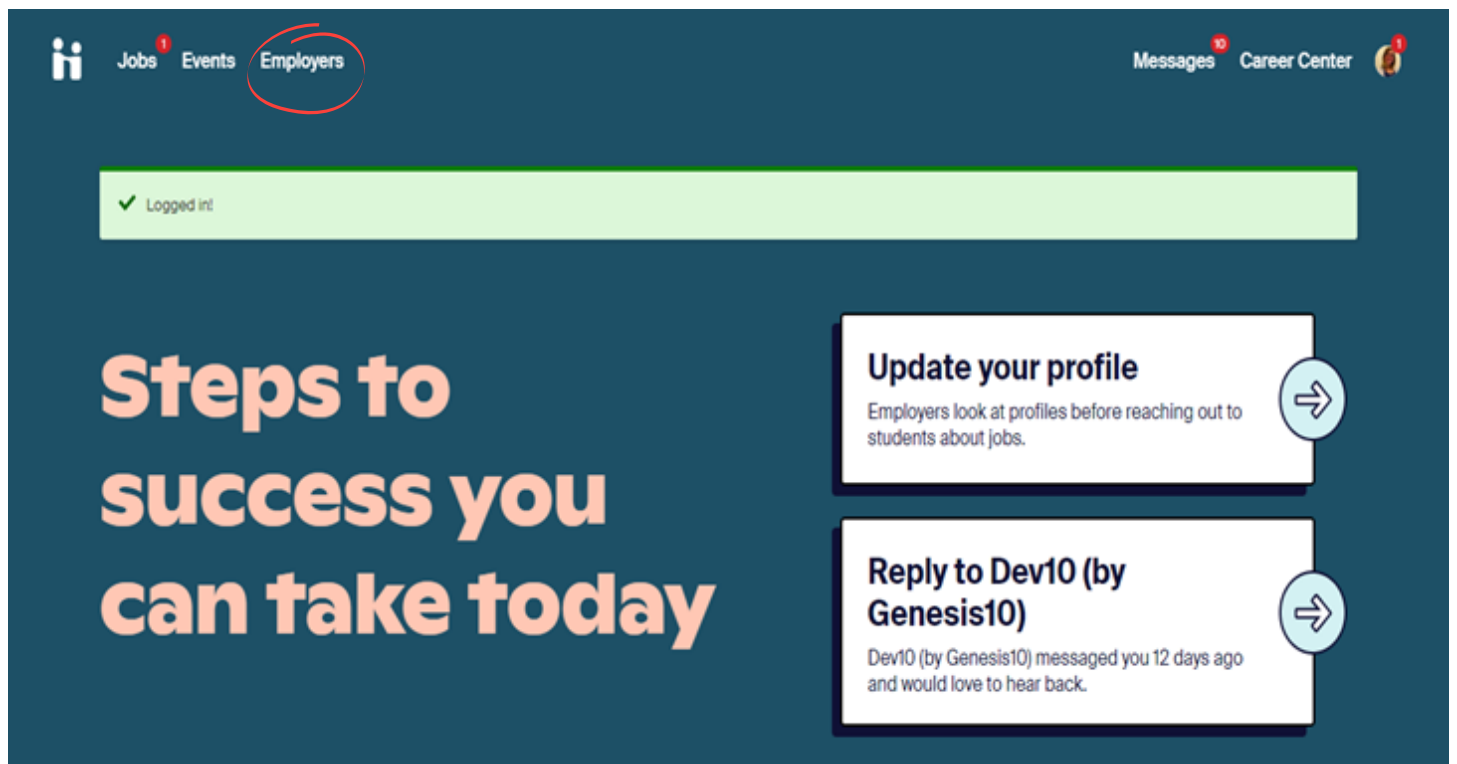

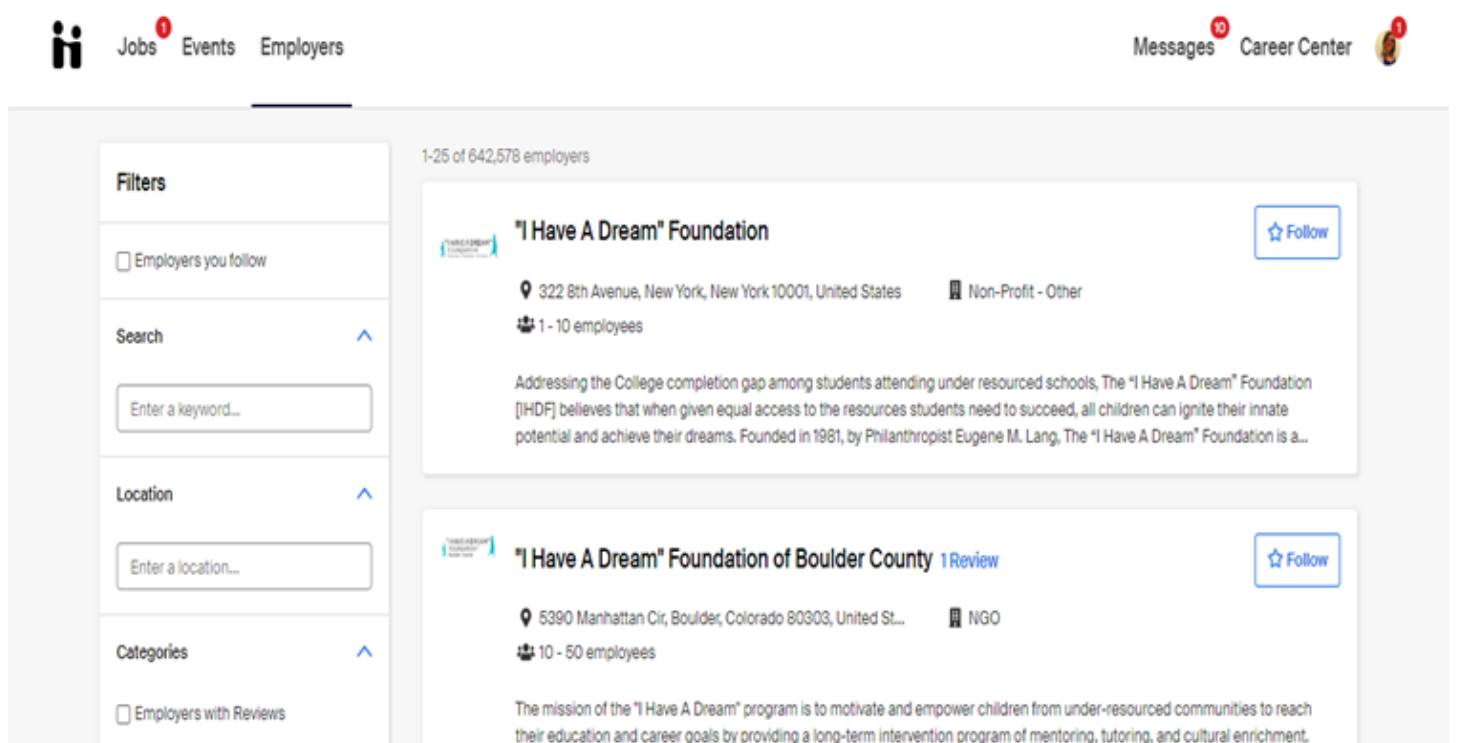
## Step 1: Login into Handshake.
